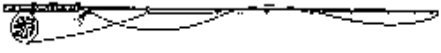
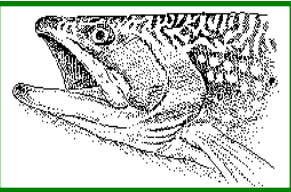


You too can learn to fly fish!
